2	Does the seat have a label with date of manufacture and model name/number?	Yes – continue	No – DESTROY
3	Was the seat made on (Today's Date), 2018 or LATER?	Yes – continue	No – DESTROY
4	Does the seat have a label showing that it meets all Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards?	Yes – continue	No – DESTROY
5	Has the seat been recalled for a safety defect? http://www-odi.nhtsa.dot.gov/cars/problems/recalls/childseat.cfm	Yes – continue to 6	No – continue to 7
6	Has the defect been corrected?	Yes – continue to 7	No – do not use until defects are corrected or <b>DESTROY</b>
7	Has the seat been involved in any vehicle crash (even a minor one)?	Yes – <b>DESTROY</b>	No – continue
8	Are there any cracks, bends or breaks in the plastic shell?	Yes – <b>DESTROY</b>	No – continue
9	Has the metal frame rusted, bent or broken?	Yes – <b>DESTROY</b>	No – continue
10	Do you have a copy of the manufacturer's instructions?	Yes - continue	No – obtain new instructions and continue or <b>DESTROY</b>
11	Does the seat have all its parts – harness straps, harness clip, seat cover, tether, padding, shield and bolts?	Yes - continue	No: obtain replacements and continue or DESTROY
12	Are the hardness straps worn or frayed?	Yes – Obtain replacements and continue or <b>DESTROY</b>	No – continue
13	Does the buckle or any other metal part show signs of rust?	Yes – Obtain replacements and continue or <b>DESTROY</b>	No – continue
14	When buckled, does the mechanism lock securely? Does it remain locked?	Yes – USE SEAT!!	No – obtain replacements and continue or DESTROY
